We keep animals safe, happy and sheltered as they wait to be adopted into loving, forever homes. We promote responsible pet guardianship and the humane treatment of animals, and work toward ending animal overpopulation through education and a variety of programs.

PET ADOPTIONS
 Our shelter is the temporary home to up to 60 cats and kittens and up to 30 dogs looking for loving safe forever homes. Our web site galleries have pictures and information about the adoptable animals in our shelter. And open house hours are when our adoption counselors are available to help when you're ready to adopt.

ANIMAL RESCUE SERVICES
 Volunteers rescue hundreds of companion animals every year from abandonment and abusive situations. These pets need the safety and shelter of loving homes. Contact us to find out more about helping an animal or more about becoming a pet.

SPAY-NEUTER-RETURN & SPAY-NEUTER
 Help to control the pet population in our community through the spay/neuter programs. Our spay/neuter program focuses on sterilizing cats who live in local colonies. The cats are taken to our shelter where they are spayed or neutered at our onsite clinic and returned to the colony for recovery. We also offer low-cost spay/neuter services as available in our clinic.
